

New City College (NCC) is the largest college group in East London. It was formed by a merger between Hackney Community College and Tower Hamlets College in 2016 and then with Redbridge College in 2017. The group merged with Epping Forest College in 2018 and Havering Sixth Form College and Havering Further Education College merged with the group in August 2019.

NCC Havering Colleges is the largest provider of Further Education in the London Borough of Havering, with a sixth form campus and two campuses delivering vocational further education courses. The sixth form campus offers the widest range of A Level and flexible BTEC qualifications in Havering and East London.

With 5,880 students drawn from a wide area covering East London, Essex and Kent, 34.7% come from 'disadvantaged uplift' postcodes. The proportion of students from minority ethnic groups attending the college is 45.3%, significantly higher than reflected in the local population.

Havering Colleges are part of the National Collaborative Outreach Project (UniConnect) which provides support and activities to encourage disadvantaged students to apply to university.
